Striped Triangle Shawl With Lace Edge

MEASUREMENTS

Width (approx)	cm	140
Depth (approx)	cm	70

YARN REQUIRED

Lincraft Denim 4ply	50g balls	
Main Colour (MC)		4
Contrast Colour (CC)		3

NEEDLES

- A pair of 3.25mm knitting needles.
- A 3.25mm circular knitting needle (80cm or longer).
- Wool needle for sewing in ends.

TENSION

28 sts and 36 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 3.25mm needles.

NOTE

SM = slip marker.

DIFFICULTY ●●●

INSTRUCTIONS

Shawl: (Begin at centre back)

Using a pair of 3.25mm needles and MC, cast on 5 sts.

1st row: K1, M1, K1, M1, place stitch marker, K1, M1, K1, M1, K1 ... 9 sts.

2nd row: Knit and SM as needed.

3rd row: Using CC, K1, M1, K3, M1, SM, K1, M1, K3, M1, K1 ... 13 sts.

4th row: K1, purl to last st and SM as needed, K1.

5th row: Using MC, K1, M1, knit to marker, M1, SM, K1, M1, knit to last st, M1, K1.

6th row: Knit and SM as needed.

7th row: Using CC, K1, M1, knit to marker, M1, SM, K1, M1, knit to last st, M1, K1.

8th row: K1, purl to last st and SM as needed, K1.

Rep last 4 rows until there are 445 sts, ending with 2 rows in CC, noting to change to a circular needle when sts no longer fit comfortably but cont to work backwards and forwards in rows, not rounds.

Beg Lace Edge:

Using MC only for rem, cont as folls:

1st row: K1, yon, [K2tog, yon] to st before marker, K1, yon, SM, K1, yon, K1, [yon, sl 1, K1, pss0] to last st, yon, K1.

2nd row: K1, * P1 tbl, P1, rep from * to last 2 sts and SM as needed, P1 tbl, K1.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows 14 times.

Cast off.

FINISHING

Block the shawl to even out the triangle shape. Sew in all ends.
