### YOU WILL NEED

- Calico
- Rit liquid dye – denim blue
- Matching thread
- Rotary cutter
- Cutting mat
- Scissors

### INSTRUCTIONS

#### Step 1:

Cut the front panel – 47cm x 47cm [allows for 1cm seam allowance. Cut the back panels, 2 x 33cm x 47cm [allows for 1cm seam allowance – the 2 back panels will overlap to enable to insert the cushion fill].

#### Step 2:

Fold the front panel in half, and then roll up.

#### Step 3:

Follow instructions on packet. Then place the rolled up calico [folded edge] into the dye. Allow the dye to seep through.

#### Step 4:

Lift the rolled calico half way out of the dye and allow the folded section to sit longer in the dye. Remove and hang out to dry.

#### Step 5:

Sew a 1cm seam on one of the longest lengths of each back panel.

#### Step 6:

With right sides together and the back panels overlapping.

#### Step 7:

Sew a 1cm seam allowance on all 4 sides of cushion. Taper off when approaching a corner – this will result in a better shape once the cushion insert is added.

#### Step 8:

Trim excess and snip corner seams. Turn right side out and press well. Add cushion insert.
