**Jute Produce Baskets**

EASY CROCHET

These baskets use a combination of jute and our cotton blend yarn to create great looking storage for your kitchen.

### MEASUREMENTS

Width (approx)	cm	20
Height (approx)	cm	12
<b>Yarn Required:</b>		
Makr Chloe	100g balls	1

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

#### ITEM A: Stitch Detail on basket



### DIFFICULTY ●●●

#### CROCHET HOOK AND EQUIPMENT:

A 10.00mm crochet hook.  
Wool needle for sewing in ends.

#### TENSION:

Tension is not important for this project.

#### CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS:

- ch:** chain  
**mr:** magic ring, alternatively ch4 and sl st to close  
**dc:** double crochet  
**tr:** treble crochet  
**dc2tog:** double crochet two stitches together, \*ins hook into next st or space, yo and pull up a loop, yo, repeat from \* once more. Yo and pull through all 3 loops on the hook, dc2tog completed.  
**dc3tog:** double crochet three stitches together, \*ins hook into next st or space, yo and pull up a loop, yo, repeat from \* twice more. Yo and pull through all 4 loops on the hook, dc3tog completed.

### BASKET

#### Base:

Using 10.00mm hook and holding two ends of Jute together, create mr and dc 12 into it.

**Round 2:** ch5 (counts as 1tr, ch2), tr into the st at the base of the 5ch, 2tr into each of the next 2 sts, \*tr, ch2, tr into the next st, 2tr in each st for the next 2 sts, repeat from \* three more times. Sl st into the 3rd ch of the 5ch at the beg of the round ... 24 tr

**Round 3:** ch5 (counts as 1tr, 2ch), tr into the st at the beg of the round, 2tr into the next st, tr into each of the next 4 sts, 2tr into the next st, \*tr, ch2, tr into the 2ch space at the corner, 2tr, into the next st, tr into each st for the next 4 sts, 2tr into the next st, repeat from \* three more times. Sl st into the 3rd ch of the 5ch at the beg of the round. ... 40 tr

**Round 4:** ch5 (counts as 1tr, 2ch), tr into the same st at the beg of the round, 2tr into the next st, tr into each st for the next 8 sts, 2tr into the next st, \*(tr, ch2, tr) into the next ch space at the corner, 2tr into the next st, tr into each st for the next 8 sts, 2tr into the next st, repeat 3 times until you have 4 corners done. Sl st to the ch space at the beg of the round. ... 56 tr

#### Sides:

**Round 1:** ch1, dc into the front post of each st in the round, sl st to close ... 56 dc

**Round 2:** ch1, dc into each st in the round, sl st to close ... 56 dc  
Repeat round 2, 3 more times.

Change to M and work round 2 a further 5 times. Cut yarn and fasten off.

### FINISHING

Weave in all ends, before use wash thoroughly and leave outside in the sun to aerate and dry entirely.
