**Plush Santa Hat**

EASY KNIT

Made in our velvety soft Luscious yarn, this hat is incredibly soft, makes up quickly and will last the holiday season for many years to come. Featuring a knitted fur trim using our Teddy Soft yarn, it's a luxurious take on the classic Santa hat. This pattern is worked in the round top down and is available in one size fits most.

### MEASUREMENTS

Size		Adult
To Fit Head Up To	cm	57
Length (approx)	cm	30
<b>Yarn Required:</b>		
Ficio Luscious	100g balls	1
Makr Teddy Soft	100g balls	1

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

### DIFFICULTY ●●●

#### KNITTING NEEDLES & EQUIPMENT:

A set of 4.50mm double pointed needles  
A 5.00mm circular needle, 40cm or longer.  
A 7.00mm circular needle, 40cm or longer.  
Yarn for Pompom.  
Pompom Maker **OR**,  
Cardboard.  
Wool needle for sewing in ends.

#### TENSION:

16.5 sts and 24 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 4.50mm needles.

#### KNITTING ABBREVIATIONS:

**K:** Knit  
**K2tog:** Knit 2 Together  
**Kfb:** K1 into the fr of the next stitch on the needle but do not slide the stitch off, K1 into the bk of the same stitch on the needle and slide the stitch off the needle  
**P:** Purl  
**P2tog:** Purl 2 Together  
**Pfb:** Purl 1, Purl tbl to increase by 1  
**Sl1:** Slip One Stitch purlwise  
**wyif:** With Yarn in Front  
**wyib:** With Yarn in Back  
**ssk:** Slip, Slip Knit (Left Slanting Decrease)

### SANTA HAT

#### Brim:

Using Teddy Soft yarn and 7.00mm circular needle, cast on 50 sts, join to begin working in the round. Taking care not to twist.

Begin working in stocking st, knitting every round. Work even until piece measures 7cm.

Work the next round, referenced below onto 5.50mm needles and using Luscious yarn.

**Next Round:** K1 \*Kfb, K1, repeat from \* to end of round, K1 ... 98 sts

Work even until piece measures 12cm from the beginning.

#### Shaping:

**Next Round:** \*K10, K2tog, repeat from \* to end of round ... 84 sts  
Work straight until piece measures 16cm from the beginning

**Next Round:** \*K12, K2tog, repeat from \* to end of round ... 78 sts  
Work 4 rounds

**Next Round:** \*K11, K2tog, repeat from \* to end of round ... 72 sts  
Work 4 rounds

**Next Round:** \*K10, K2tog, repeat from \* to end of round ... 66 sts  
Work 4 rounds

**Next Round:** \*K9, K2tog, repeat from \* to end of round ... 60 sts  
Work 3 rounds

**Next Round:** \*K8, K2tog, repeat from \* to end of round ... 54 sts  
Work 3 rounds

**Next Round:** \*K7, K2tog, repeat from \* to end of round ... 48 sts  
Work 3 rounds

**Next Round:** \*K6, K2tog, repeat from \* to end of round ... 42 sts

Work 3 rounds

**Next Round:** \*K5, K2tog, repeat from \* to end of round ... 36 sts

Work 3 rounds

**Next Round:** \*K4, K2tog, repeat from \* to end of round ... 30 sts

Work 3 rounds

**Next Round:** \*K3, K2tog, repeat from \* to end of round ... 24 sts

Work 3 rounds

**Next Round:** \*K2, K2tog, repeat from \* to end of round ... 18 sts

Work 2 rounds

**Next Round:** \*K1, K2tog, repeat from \* to end of round ... 12 sts

Work 2 rounds

**Next Round:** \*K2tog, repeat from \* to end of round ... 6 sts

Cut yarn and draw through remaining sts, drawing together tightly and fastening off.

### FINISHING

Weave in all ends and stretch gently into shape. If desired, make a matching pompom using a pompom maker or cut card templates to 10cm diameter and trim to shape, taking off any uneven ends. Sew in place at the top of the hat.
